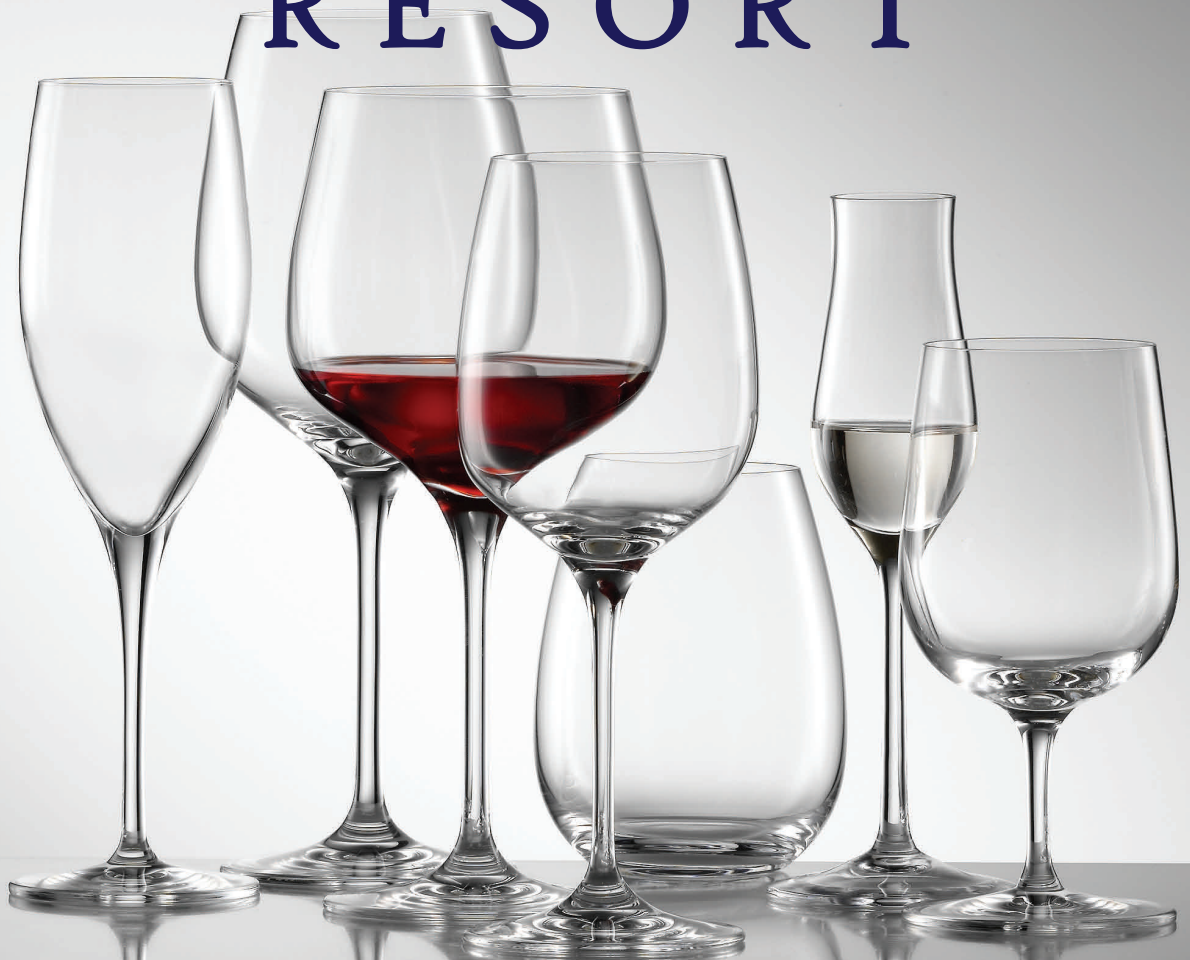

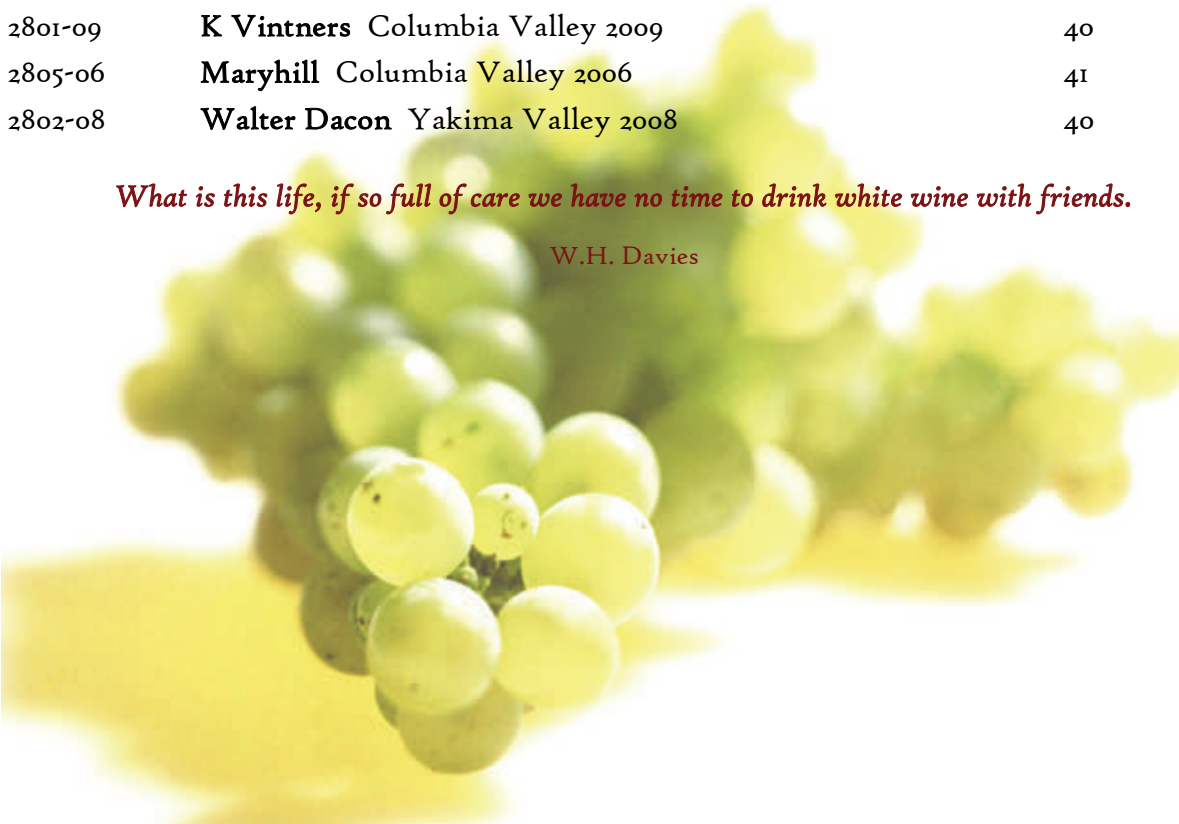

“This wine includes 6% Cab Franc, which shows immediately in the floral elements as well as providing an underlying minerality. 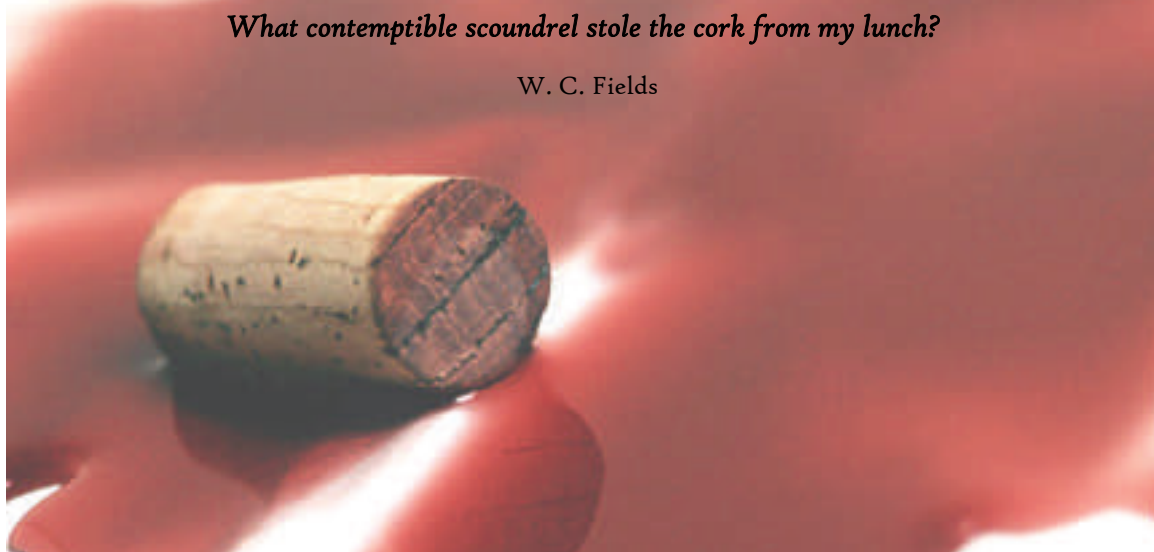

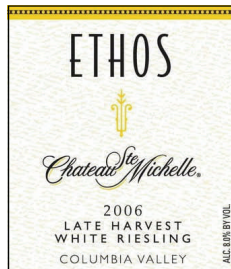
